

ee. Camp Pringle Policy on Fees and Camp Participation for Children of Volunteers

Children of volunteers are welcome! We enjoy having families as part of our camping community, and appreciate when volunteers make the effort to balance their camp work with family responsibilities! The following policies are in place for two reasons: (1) to ensure that you and your child(ren) know where they fit into the camp program, and therefore will feel comfortable; and (2) to help the Camp cover costs over the summer. As we are a non-profit organization, our finances are always a concern, and we appreciate your understanding in helping us stay within budget.

- 1) One adult volunteer and one child (under the age of 6 years) stay at Camp Pringle at no cost during the week – children 6yrs and up pay the weekly food costs. For each additional child (under 6yrs old) or adult (e.g., spouse), we ask that \$55/child under 6yrs, \$82/6yrs-12yrs and \$110 per adult is paid, to cover food costs.
- 2) Please fill out camper forms (medical and Confidential) for your child(ren) and yourself, so that the Camp Medic and your child(ren)'s Leader(s) are informed of relevant medical and personal information.
- 3) If your child participates in camp activities and stays in a cabin during the week, volunteers are asked to pay the registration fee. We subsidize our camps and registrations are important to our financial viability. If you are unable to pay the registration fee, you can apply for a camp bursary.
- 4) If your child is the same age as the campers and wishes to participate in activities during the day, but still sleep with you at night, we can make arrangements to put your child in a rotation group for activities. Your child can then return to your room for sleeping accommodations. You do not have to pay a full registration fee for your child but a third of the fee is required to participate in activities during the day.
- 5) If you have a guest/visitor come to Camp, please talk with the Camp Director beforehand, to make sure that the guest is introduced publicly to all the campers. Visitors are welcome to join us for meals during the week; the cost for meals is \$6 – breakfast, \$8 – lunch, and \$10 – supper regardless of the meal served. This payment is to be made to the Camp Director, (please pay prior to the meal and if a guest is expected in advance, payment made on arrival would be appreciated.)
