Camp Pringle is pleased to be offering affordable family vacation rentals for the summer of 2020! These weekend rentals are geared towards members of the Camp Pringle community. At Camp Pringle we pride ourselves on being welcoming and inclusive to campers of all ages, abilities and identities! While enjoying your weekend please remember “*the 3 R’s*” of camp; Respect the camp environment, Respect others and Respect yourself.

Camp Pringle General Rules & Guidelines

Please ensure your family adheres to the following general camp rules & guidelines. Failure to adhere to the camp rules may result in dismissal from the property at Camp Pringle's discretion.

- **ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE** – Check in on Fridays begins at 5:30pm (early arrivals can NOT be accommodated due to our day camp programs). Check out on Sundays is no later than 2:30pm. On the August long weekend, Monday check out is by 10:00am.
- **CHANGES & CANCELLATIONS** – You may change or cancel your booking up until 14 days prior to your arrival at Camp Pringle and receive a refund (less a \$40.00 cancellation fee). Cancellations or changes within 14 days of your arrival, for non-medical reasons, (see info below) will not be refunded. There are no refunds for rain or inclement weather.
- **PETS** – We regret that pets are not allowed on property. If you have a registered service animal please contact our office to make arrangements to have them accompany you.
- **THEFT & DAMAGE** – Camp Pringle is not responsible for theft or damage of personal property that occurs at Camp Pringle. Our cabins do not lock so please leave valuables at home or store in your vehicles.
- **NOISE & QUIET HOURS** - Excessive noise is not permitted. Please be courteous of other guests and remember that sound travels further in open air, especially music and loud talking. *Quiet hours at Camp Pringle are 10:00pm-8:00am.*
- **FIRST AID & EMERGENCIES** – First aid supplies will not be provided so please bring a small kit for your family. In case of emergency please alert the nearest Camp Pringle staff member or our residential caretaker immediately to respond to the emergency. All cabins are equipped with smoke detectors and a fire extinguisher.
- **GUEST SERVICES** – We have on-call staff available from 8am-8pm if you require assistance during your stay. Support outside these hours is for emergencies only. Camp Pringle staff will be easily identified by their staff t-shirts and are happy to help!
- **VISITORS** - Visitors are not permitted and site access is restricted to registered campers only. This will ensure we maintain a maximum of 50 people at our site for the health & safety of our campers and staff. All registered campers will be given a bracelet and must wear it throughout the weekend to be easily identified as a registered camper. Please arrange to visit with external visitors at the provincial park next door or in Shawnigan Lake village.

- **WATERFRONT** – The Camp Pringle waterfront is CLOSED except during designated times when Camp Pringle lifeguards are available. Please bring your own lifejackets. The provincial park next door is available dawn to dusk for swimming outside our lifeguard's hours.
- **FACILITATED ACTIVITIES** – Your family may sign up for 1hr activity sessions of Archery, Canoeing, Kayaking, Rock Climbing or Paddle Boarding. You must bring your own lifejackets for boating. **Masks must be worn for Archery & Rock Climbing where a 2meter physical distance cannot always be maintained.** A guardian must supervise children during facilitated program activities and families must complete the online Household Program Waiver to participate in our facilitated activities.
- **CHILDCARE** – Childcare is NOT provided and you are responsible for your children throughout the week-end. Please supervise your children at all times including during programmed activity sessions (archery etc.) and at the waterfront.
- **SMOKING & VAPING** - Smoking and/or vaping is not permitted on the camp property except in the designated area in our parking lot. Please dispose of butts in the provided fire-safe garbage bin.
- **ALCOHOL** – Alcohol consumption is prohibited on property except inside your cabin or at your assigned picnic table. No glass containers are permitted. Belligerent drinking will not be tolerated. The Camp Pringle staff reserves the right to prohibit a guest from participating in swimming, boating, archery or rock climbing if they are under the influence of alcohol.
- **DRUGS** – Drug use is not permitted.
- **FIREARMS** - For the safety of campers and staff, firearms and weapons are prohibited.
- **HARASSMENT** - Harassment of any kind towards a Camp Pringle staff member or any other registered guest will not be tolerated.
- **WASHROOM FACILITIES** – we are pleased to provide bathrooms & shower facilities onsite in the “North Pole” building. These facilities will be cleaned daily. Each cabin booking will be assigned a bathroom & shower stall. Please wear shoes inside the washroom & shower facilities. All washroom facilities are universal gender.
- **PARKING** – Parking is restricted to the parking lot only. Please plan to carry your gear 100-200 meters from the parking lot to your cabin.
- **COOKING** - Cooking must be done using gas/propane stoves, NOT a campfire. Guests should bring a dishwashing bin (warm water is available). Please bring biodegradable or eco-friendly dish soap.
- **CLEANING** – At Camp Pringle we practice “no trace” camping. At the end of your weekend stay please sweep out your bunks and cabins with the broom and dustpan provided and ensure your picnic area is left tidy. If any extensive cleaning is required a fee may be charged.
- **GARBAGE & RECYCLING** – There are dumpsters located in the parking lot for garbage & recycling disposal. Please ensure no refuse is left in or around your cabin site prior to departing.

- **CAMPFIRES** – Campfires are restricted to our designated campfire pit and are not permitted next to your cabin. Guests may reserve a campfire time and will be provided firewood. No fires are to be lit without express permission of the site caretaker and if a fire ban is in place no fires will be permitted.
- **WIFI & PHONES** – There is no public pay phone on site. There are outlets inside the “North Pole” bathroom & shower building to charge cell phones if needed. Cabin users with a Shaw email account may connect to our free Shaw Open wifi hotspot. We encourage your family, if able, to disconnect from technology for the weekend and enjoy our beautiful property!
- **PLANTS** - Please do not break branches or pull flowers. Leave shrubs, flowers and others plants to grow.
- **WILDLIFE** - Camp Pringle is home to birds, deer, rabbits & squirrels. Please ensure all food/drinks are packed up securely each night to avoid attracting animals to the cabins. We have an outdoor cat that lives on site. Please do not feed the cat or bring him inside your cabin.

Camp Pringle COVID-19 Policies

In addition to the camp rules outlined above, please be aware of the additional COVID-19 policies in place to keep weekend campers and staff members safe. Please ensure your household adheres to these guidelines recommended by local & provincial health authorities. Failure to adhere to these policies may result in dismissal from the Camp Pringle property.

- **MAINTAIN PHYSICAL DISTANCE** - Please ensure your children and all members of your household stay at least 2 meters apart from other registered guests and Camp Pringle staff members at all times.
- **WHEN TO STAY HOME** - Please do NOT come to Camp Pringle if you or any member of your household has... **A)** Travelled outside of Canada within 14 days of your arrival at Camp Pringle AND/OR **B)** Tested positive for COVID-19 or is displaying any symptoms of COVID-19 within 14 days of your arrival at Camp Pringle. Please complete a self-assessment prior to your weekend booking. This can be done online at <https://bc.thrive.health/covid19/en> AND/OR **C)** Has been in contact with someone outside your household who has tested positive for COVID-19 within 14 days of your arrival at Camp Pringle.

* If you suspect your or any member of your household has COVID-19 you may cancel your booking and receive a refund (less a \$40.00 administration fee). If you provide a doctors note we will waive the \$40.00 cancellation fee.
